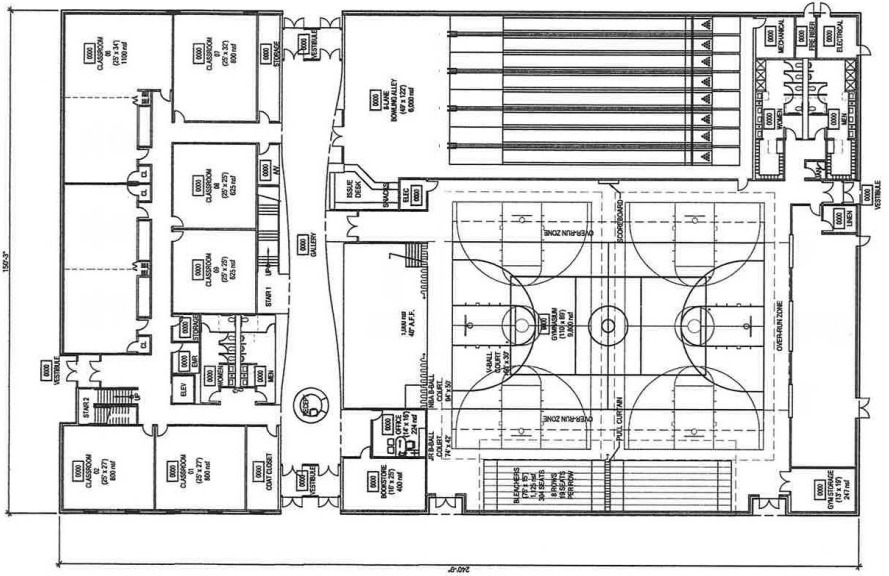

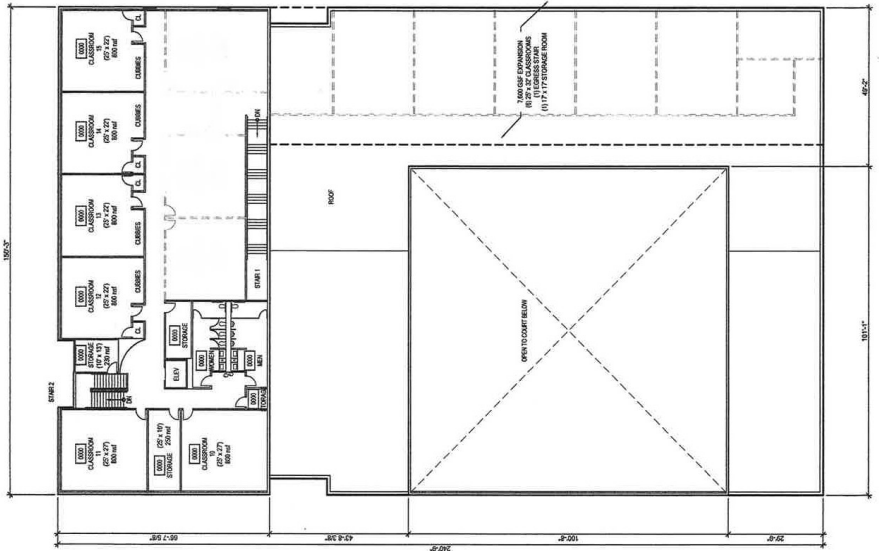


# SBC COMMUNITY CENTER
